In the New Year, the builders will move in to make our building very safe. They will be stripping back the floors and lower walls. There are some internal wall cavities which are still full of water and these cavities will need completely stripping out before they can be rebuilt.

Once the foundations have been constructed and they have been delivered to site, then plumbing and electrics will be fitted. Each classroom will have two toilets and a wet area.
