



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

KS1 Party 6pm-7pm / KS2 Party 7.15pm-8.15pm

To help ensure the safe running of the Friends of Millfield PTA Festive Party, please carefully read the following information.

- > Children are to be brought to Jubilee Hall, Heighington by their parent/carer.
- They are to bring a completed permission slip and the correct amount of admission money (even if a parent/carer is staying as a PTA helper).
- > All Children are to enter the building by the rear fire exit door of Jubilee Hall labelled the parish council (please go round to the back of the hall and queue in the car park)
- > They will then go into the main hall where the party will take place.
- Parents/carers leave their children once they are in the building. Due to restricted space parents/carers are asked to take their child's jacket home with them and bring them back for collection. There will be members of staff and PTA members present during the course of the evening to supervise the children.
- > Once the party has finished, Parents can collect their children by entering the hall emergency exit to the rear of Jubilee Hall and exiting through the front door with your child.
- > This will make sure that children can enter and exit as quickly and efficiently as possible
- > No child will be allowed to leave the building without a responsible adult.

The disco entrance fee is £3.00 per child. We are asking that children bring the correct amount of admission money as this greatly reduces queueing time, we will not be giving out change.

For KS1 & KS2: There will be small bags of sweets, glowsticks and glitter tattoos on sale. Sweets and glowsticks will cost 20p. Glitter Tattoos and Face Glitter will cost £1.00. Squash/Water will be provided for free by the PTA.

Belvin Construction have very kindly offered to fund-match the Festive Party event which means they will donate the same amount of money as the PTA makes (up to £500.00).

Please ensure your child brings their money in a suitable purse/wallet/bag with their name on it. Can we ask that children DO NOT bring their mobile phones. Thank you for your co-operation and support.

Help to clear refreshments away, dispose of rubbish and sweep hall.

Help to ensure all pupils are safely reunited with parents/carers.
