#### Minister Visit - Flooding Update

The academy received a visit on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> January from the government's Minister for Water and Rural Growth, Robbie Moore MP, as well as the Chair of the Environment Agency, Alan Lovell. They were joined by Dr Caroline Johnson MP and County Councillor Ian Carrington, while the Trust was represented by myself, the CEO, Primary Executive and the Head of Central Services. The Minister was fully supportive of the academy's case and agreed that effective flood protection measures were imperative – we will keep you regularly informed of the developments.



We are still working towards a re-opening of the main school buildings in September 2024.

# **Mobile Classroom Update**

Our next two mobile classrooms are due to be delivered to the academy site today, 12<sup>th</sup> January, with another two arriving the following week. It is likely that these



deliveries, and those to come in the weeks ahead, will cause a minor degree of traffic disruption while each unit is unloaded. However, it does mean that we remain on track to have all our pupils back on site after February half-term.

Until then, the children's teaching and learning is continuing successfully at two of our sister academies (Priory Witham and Priory LSST). We will remain with our new system of picking children up in their class 'zones'. Thank you for being so understanding with this as the safety of children is our priority.
