Vulcan – Tuesday and Wednesday

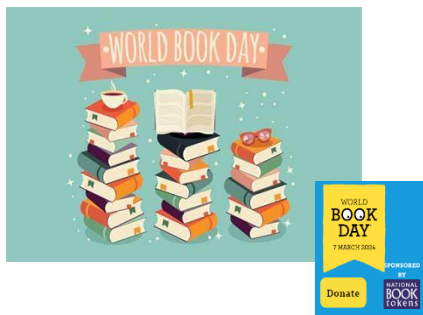
