A few reminders about next year ...

Smart, Proud and Ready for September

A little reminder ahead of September that all children must return to school wearing the correct school uniform. A full uniform list can be found on our school website.

If the sunshine decides to stay with us into September, children may continue to wear summer dresses and summer shorts. However, please ensure children wear dark grey or black socks. White sports socks, particularly those with large sports logos, are not part of our school uniform. Children must also wear appropriate black school shoes and not trainers.

Please remember that nail varnish is not permitted. In terms of jewellery, children may wear one single stud earring in each ear only. No other jewellery should be worn in school.

Home Toys Stay at Home!

Please ensure that children do not bring toys from home into school, even if they intend to keep them inside their school bag. We know it can be tempting to bring a favourite item in, but children can quickly become distracted and may take toys out during the school day, which can then result in consequences.



For children who require sensory support, school will provide appropriate sensory tools and resources, such as fiddle tools. These are not toys and are used specifically to support a child's individual needs. Sensory tools should only be used and provided by school where this has been agreed with our SENCO, Mrs O'Neill.

Book It, Don't Risk It!

Our Breakfast Club is becoming increasingly busy, so please remember that all Breakfast Club places must be booked through ParentPay.

Unfortunately, we are no longer able to simply 'squeeze children in' as we may have been able to do in the past. Using the formal booking process allows us to ensure that we have the correct staffing and provision in place for all children attending.

Please also remember to book your child's school meals on time through Good Lookin Cookin. A little organisation goes a long way and helps us make sure everything runs smoothly for your children!



Ready for the School Week

Finally, please ensure that children bring all appropriate belongings they need for the school day. School provides all essential classroom resources, including pens and pencils, so children do not need to bring their own stationery from home.

Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school at the beginning of each week. PE kits should be taken home on a Friday to be washed and returned ready for the following week.
