ECO Council News

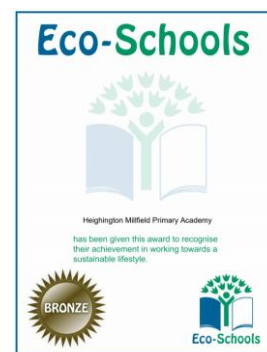
