We have noticed a large number of our younger children using the junior adventure trail at the end of the school day; this equipment is used by the afterschool club. If you are collecting your child, please ensure that they are supervised and kept with you once we have handed them over to you so that the club can get up and running as soon as their children arrive. It is not really safe for infant children due to its size.

#### **COVID**

We would like to thank everyone for their support as this half-term ends. We have had 10 children over the course of the half term who have tested positive for COVID – this includes the children who tested positive before the start of term. Thank you for continuing to monitor your children for symptoms and for taking them for PCR tests when requested. As stated previously, we will no longer contact you if there is a positive PCR result in your child's class as NHS Track and Trace are now dealing with positives cases so it is really important that you take your child for a PCR should they have any of the three symptoms – a high temperature, a persistent cough or the loss of taste or smell. The guidance from the DfE no longer requires isolation of children or fully vaccinated staff if they have been in close contact of a positive case.

We will continue to sanitise / wash hands and ventilate rooms.

We have decided to open school to adults, so from Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November we are inviting parents to join celebration assembly if their child is an achiever – you will receive an APP or text message on the Wednesday before this happens. We ask that you only come if you are symptom free and it would be lovely if you could undertake a lateral flow test prior to attending. We are building up to our Christmas events – please see the dates below.

If your child is walking home alone after school and they bring a mobile phone into school with them, please can you remind them that their phone needs to be handed into their class teacher at the start of the day, and can then be collected at the end of the day.

## Friends of Millfield PTA Disco - Thursday 21st October 2021

KS1 Disco 6pm-7pm / KS2 Disco 7.15pm-8.15pm

To help ensure the safe running of the Friends of Millfield PTA Disco, please carefully read the following information.

- > Children are to be brought to school by their parent/carer.
- They are to bring a completed permission slip and the correct amount of admission money (even if a parent/carer is staying as a PTA helper).
- Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 Children are to enter the school building by the door leading to the junior corridor (to the right of the main hall double doors in the playground).
- Year 3 and Year 4 Children are to enter the school building by the fire door leading to Mr Wise (Willow) classroom.
- Year 5 and Year 6 Children are to enter the school building by the fire door leading to Miss Broadhurst (Typhoon) classroom.
- > They will then go into the main hall where the disco will take place.
- Parents/carers leave their children once they are in the building. There will be members of staff and PTA members present during the course of the evening to supervise the children.
- Once the disco has finished, parents/carers will enter the building via the library doors (on the far side of the hall double doors) to collect their children from the main hall.
- No child will be allowed to leave the building without a responsible adult.

The disco entrance fee is £2.00 per child. We are asking that children bring the correct amount of admission money as this greatly reduces queuing time, we will not be giving out change.

For KS1: There will be small bags of sweets on sale. Sweets will cost 20p. Squash/Water will be provided for free by the PTA.

For KS2: There will be a sweet stall with a range of pre-packed sweets available to buy. Squash/Water will be provided for free by the PTA.

Please ensure your child brings their money in a suitable purse/wallet/bag with their name on it. Can we ask that children DO NOT bring their mobile phones.

Sell sweets/drinks.

Supervise dance floor (quard doors and check children are not misbehaving).

Supervise corridor/toilets (usually staff as DBS check necessary).

Help to clear refreshments away, dispose of rubbish and sweep hall.

Help to ensure all pupils are safely reunited with parents/carers.
