Lincolnshire Early Years support and Learning provision

KIDS have been commissioned by Lincolnshire County Council to deliver Early Support and Learning Provision sessions for disabled children and those with complex health needs across the county. The service is for all parents / carers with children under 5. KIDS' Early Support and Learning Provision sessions last 2 hours, with an additional parent support hour either before or after the session.

This service is free of charge although there is a discretionary parental contribution of up to £5 per session.

Learning Provision sessions are available once a week from Children's Centres at: Lincoln City North and Birchwood,
