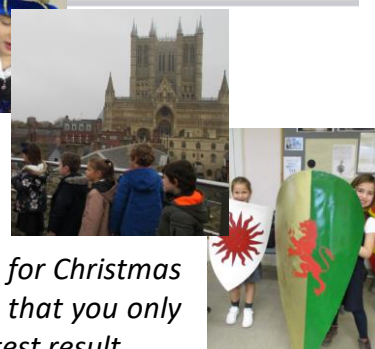
Anti-Bullying Week
