



What is Coronavirus home testing?

A visual story explaining the Coronavirus home testing kit




I have to have a special test because I don't feel well





To find out what is wrong, I have to have a special test called a swab test





The test will be done by my parent or a nurse with my parent there.

Swab test steps

My parent or the nurse will wash their hands.









After, I will open my mouth wide so they can put the swab in.

It will not take long.

It might feel uncomfortable and make me cough.

Next, they will put the swab up my nose.

It will not take long.

It might feel uncomfortable and make me sneeze.





The test will be sent to the hospital laboratory.

They will find out why I don't feel well.

In 3 days' time, the hospital will tell my family why I don't feel well.



Soon I will feel better.
