### **COVID updates**

As you will be aware, the government has updated some elements of its guidance in relation to Covid-19 protocols. If your child has symptoms of Covid-19, the same advice remains in place: isolate, take a PCR test and follow the national guidance regarding isolation if the test is positive.

At the moment the guidance [COVID-19 Response: Living with COVID-19 - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/guidance/covid-19-response-living-with-covid-19) states -

The legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. Adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people. After 5 days, they may choose to take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) followed by another the next day - if both are negative, and they do not have a temperature, they can safely return to their normal routine.

National advice continues to be clarified and updated on a frequent basis. We will continue to keep you informed of any changes as and when they come into force.
