We are sure you have been following the recent world news events. Whilst we have not covered this in school, we would like to help in a small way.

We are collecting items for refugees who have fled Ukraine and are now in Poland. All goods will be transported to Poland by either registered charities or private transport. If you wish to donate any of the following items, please send them to school with your child by Friday 18th March:

Dry food, cans, thermal clothes only, power banks, batteries of all sorts, camping cups, plates, bowls, cutlery, thermal blankets, First Aid items (bandages and plasters), Panadol for adults and children, cough medicine, antibacterial sprays/gels, antiseptic creams, gloves, anti-noise headphones, baby formula, wipes, nappies, toiletries, sanitary products, bottles and dummies. The Charity organising the collection are the ERMED CHARITY Based in Poland Wroclaw. There is no obligation to contribute but any of the above donations will be gratefully received.

Dylan, from Year 4, would like to collect some money to help, so we are also holding a non-uniform day, next Friday 11th March. We are asking that children wear the colours of the Ukraine flag, blue and yellow, for a minimum donation of £1. All proceeds will be gifted to the Red Cross, to help the Ukraine refugees.
