COVID Updates

Unfortunately, we have three members of staff and several children off with Covid. If your child has symptoms of Covid-19, the same advice remains in place: isolate, take a test and follow the national guidance regarding isolation if the test is positive. The legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. Adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people. After 5 days they may choose to take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) followed by another the next day – if both are negative, and they do not have a temperature, they can safely return to their normal routine. National advice continues to be clarified and updated on a frequent basis. We will continue to keep you informed of any changes as and when they come into force.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Friends of Millfield PTA Disco - Thursday 31st March 2022

KS1 Disco 6pm-7pm / KS2 Disco 7.15pm-8.15pm

To help ensure the safe running of the Friends of Millfield PTA Disco, please carefully read the following information.

- Children are to be brought to school by their parent/carer.
- They are to bring a **completed permission slip** and the **correct amount of admission money** (even if a parent/carer is staying as a PTA helper).
- All children are to enter the school building by the door leading to the junior corridor (to the right of the main hall double doors in the playground).
- They will then go into the main hall where the disco will take place.
- Parents/carers leave their children once they are in the building. There will be members of staff and PTA members present during the course of the evening to supervise the children.
- Once the disco has finished, Parents will enter the building via the library doors (on the far side of the hall double doors) to collect their children from the main hall.
- **No child will be allowed to leave the building without a responsible adult.**

The disco entrance fee is £2.00 per child. We are asking that children bring the correct amount of admission money as this greatly reduces queuing time, **we will not be giving out change.**

For All Children: There will be small bags of sweets on sale. Sweets will cost 20p. Squash/Water will be provided for free by the PTA.

Please ensure your child brings their money in a suitable purse/wallet/bag with their name on it. **Can we ask that children DO NOT bring their mobile phones.**

Friends of Millfield PTA are always looking for volunteers to help out at the Disco, here's an idea of what the volunteers do on the night. This is limited to the first 10 volunteers.

Infant KS1 Disco

Turn up 15 minutes early to help set up (you can bring your child early too).

Sell sweets/drinks.

Supervise dance floor (guard doors and check children are not misbehaving).

Supervise corridors/toilets (usually staff as DBS check necessary).

Help to tidy before next disco and pick up any lost property.

Help safely reunite infant children with parents/carers before they leave the building.

Junior KS2 Disco

Help tidy up between discos.

Sell sweets/drinks.

Supervise dance floor (guard doors and check children are not misbehaving).

Supervise corridor/toilets (usually staff as DBS check necessary).

Help to clear refreshments away, dispose of rubbish and sweep hall.

Help to ensure all pupils are safely reunited with parents/carers.
