### COVID Updates

The Government have recently updated the national and school guidance on the next steps for living with COVID. Below are key parts of the information, which you may find helpful.

The population now has much stronger protection against COVID-19 than at any other point in the pandemic. This means we can begin to manage the virus like other respiratory infections, thanks to the success of the vaccination programme and access to antivirals, alongside natural immunity and increased scientific and public understanding about how to manage risk.

This will mean:

- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.
- Children and young people aged 18 and under with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days.
- Adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious.

### **White Rose 1-Minute Maths App**

#### **What's the app about?**

*This first version of the app is aimed at Key Stage 1 pupils (ie, age 5-6 years). Individual one-minute tasks focus on adding and subtracting – and on 'Subitising', the skill of instantly recognising the number of items in a group without counting. Multiplication and division topics are also now available!*

#### **Multiplication and division**

*Two new topics have been added to the 1-Minute Maths app! The app now includes a range of new tasks based on multiplication and division to accompany the addition and subtraction-based tasks available since its launch in January, covering all four rules of arithmetic children learn during Key Stage 1. There are 13 new multiplication tasks to try along with 9 new tasks for division!*

*We have also added a number of new hint screens to the app; including arrays, number lines, bar models and ten-frames! Plus, you will now see new equal groups questions!*

#### **How do we use it?**

*Your child can choose any topic they want to try. They then answer a unique series of questions (so it's a different set of questions every time). If they are struggling with a question, a 'Hint' button will give a helpful clue by showing the question in a different but familiar way. When the one minute is up, they will see a feedback screen telling them how they have done. Download it from your app store.*
