Whether it is a tasty stew or indulgent dessert, slow cookers can surprise you with the breadth of meals they can cook as well as the taste and ease. Suggestions accommodated to help you learn how to prepare a meal that you are more interested in learning. Discover more about batch-cooking, buying cheaper produce and bulking out with healthy veg. With portions averaging at less than £1 this is fantastic for people who want to save money on food as well as through using energy (and time) saving devices.

Family, friends and making your food go further – Learn how to make your weekly shop go further, how to batch-cook and how to use cheap and readily available produce to make your meals tastier, healthier and more cost effective. Everyone needs to make their money go further and this course will help people save money, make tastier and healthier food as well as reduce waste. We refer people to the Community Grocery Store and will also discuss where and when to find a food 'bargain'. People will be able to taste the meals we make to inspire them to try at home, we will also promote ongoing engagement to see what people are making at home after each session.

To help ensure the safe running of the Friends of Millfield PTA Disco, please carefully read the following information.

- Children are to be brought to school by their parent/carer.
- They are to bring a **completed permission slip** and the **correct amount of admission money** (even if a parent/carer is staying as a PTA helper).
- All Children are to enter the school building by the door leading to the junior corridor (to the right of the main hall double doors in the playground).

- They will then go into the main hall where the disco will take place.
- Parents/carers leave their children once they are in the building. There will be members of staff and PTA members present during the course of the evening to supervise the children.
- Once the disco has finished, Parents will enter the building via the library doors (on the far side of the hall double doors) to collect their children from the main hall.
- **No child will be allowed to leave the building without a responsible adult.**

The disco entrance fee is **£3.00** per child. We are asking that children bring the correct amount of admission money as this greatly reduces queueing time, **we will not be giving out change.**

For KS1: There will be small bags of sweets and glowsticks on sale. Sweets and glowsticks will cost 20p. Squash/Water will be provided for free by the PTA.

For KS2: There will be **pick and mix** and small bags of sweets on sale. There will also be glitter tattoos, face glitter and glowsticks on sale. Sweets and glowsticks will cost 20p each. Glitter tattoos and face glitter will cost £1.00 each. Squash/Water will be provided for free by the PTA.

Please ensure your child brings their money in a suitable purse/wallet/bag with their name on it. **Can we ask that children DO NOT bring their mobile phones.** Thank you for your co-operation and support.

PTA Disco Volunteers Always Appreciated!

Help to tidy before next disco and pick up any lost property.

Help safely reunite infant children with parents/carers before they leave the building.

Junior KS2 Disco

Help tidy up between discos.

Sell sweets/drinks.

Supervise dance floor (guard doors and check children are not misbehaving).

Supervise corridor/toilets (usually staff as DBS check necessary).

Help to clear refreshments away, dispose of rubbish and sweep hall.

Help to ensure all pupils are safely reunited with parents/carers.
